### **Bears**

As the leaves on the trees change and fall descends upon the valley we would like to remind everyone of the importance of adhering to the Bear Conflict Mitigation standards set forth by Teton County Idaho. These are for the protection of both bears and humans. These include the following:

- \* Trash cans should be certified bear resistant containers. However if an owner chooses not to use them trash should be placed out at the end of the driveway no earlier than 8am and returned to a bear proof structure no later than 6pm. Cans should be stored inside bear proof structures on non-pick up days.
- \* Bird feeders should be at least 10 feet from the ground, deck, railing or surface and four feet from any structure, tree limb and should have a catch pan attached directly underneath that is 2" larger in diameter than the widest diameter of the feeder itself.


